Despite a severe psychiatric illness which may include severe violent outbursts artists have the potential to overcome the isolation and stigma involved by using their artistic productivity. Often new forms evolve and allow novel perspectives on the previously known.

The exhibition focuses on psychiatric art in exemplary artworks from various countries worldwide, including artists represented in museums and galleries as well as those working in hospitals or even in hidden isolation.

The emphasis of the exhibition will be on artistic examples of dissolving forms as well as on their reconstruction symbolizing the vast possibilities of opening our eyes to new modes of perception and integrating our thinking into previously unthought territories in order to overcome barriers – between physical and mental health as well as between those considered ill and those considered more or less healthy.

At the same time it becomes obvious how art can become a releasing channel for emotional burdens and thus provide a therapeutic tool against violence by preventing severe emotional peaks to build up.
